Presentation of the performance

What games do we play when we first meet? In the piece *ENTRE DEUX*, the audience follows two protagonists in an acrobatic dance as they explore their possibilities, embrace opportunities, test their boundaries, and balance their desires.

To do so, they transform a ping-pong table—an omnipresent urban object in public space—into their 360-degree stage.

At the intersection of Art du Déplacement/Parkour and partnering, the Potsdam-based company 101concrete challenges the conventional use of urban furniture and explores what connects us to space—and, above all, to each other.

Performance outline

The performance begins with a playful interaction with the audience: spectators are invited to take part

in simple, non-verbal games that are easy to understand and inclusive. The two performers then

continue the game between themselves on a ping-pong table. Through a series of gradually evolving

movements, their physical dialogue becomes increasingly complex. The net—initially a clear boundary

—slowly loses its separating function. The piece transitions into a duet of acrobatic movements, as the

performers fluidly cross from one side of the table to the other. In the final moments, they gently return

to the ground and exit the stage space in a spirit of play.

About the company

Founded in 2021, the German company 101concrete brings Art du Déplacement (parkour) to the

stage. The company's first production, 101concrete, offers insight into this discipline, which the two

founders, Stevie Koglin and Lukas Schapp, have been practicing for over ten years. Their second

piece, Assemblage, combines Art du Déplacement, dance, and acrobatics, and brings together six

artists from diverse backgrounds including music, circus, and dance. ENTRE DEUX is the company's

third creation.

Cat Gerrard (dramaturge)

Cat is a storyteller, dramaturge, performer, and educator from the UK, currently based in Berlin. She trained as an actor at Drama Studio London and creates theatre and performance works at Arthaus Berlin. In 2022, she supported the research process for the piece *Assemblage*.
